RECOMMENDED USAGE

All Areas - Soapstone is a metamorphic rock that is comprised primarily of talc with varying amounts of dolomite, magnesite, and other minerals. Soapstone generally has a smooth feel to the touch. It is used for countertops and other various building aspects such as sinks and heaters. Soapstone is a very popular choice for countertops in laboratories and classrooms due to its high resistance to chemicals. Soapstone has limited hardness and is easily scratched. Soapstone is typically treated with a food grade mineral oil to retain its luster and to mask small scratches that are often common because of its talc contents.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Do's

- Clean up spills in a resonable amount of time.
- Use clean water or PH neutral stone cleaner for daily cleaning
- Seal porous stone every 1-3 years

Don'ts

- Do not use any chemical based cleaners with bleach, ammonia, or acids.
- Keep acidic or alkaline products from contact of marbles, limestone, travertine, onyx, basalt products. This will cause etching.
- Do not cut on top of natural stones, granite may not scratch but will dull knife edge and could imbed metal into the surface.
- Do not sit, stand or place large amounts of weight on the front or back of cutouts, overhangs, or suspended bar tops.
